

When you think of a hero, what character traits come to mind? Heritage heroes <u>Help others</u>, <u>work</u> <u>Ethically</u>, <u>show Respect</u>, are <u>Otherwise amazing</u>, <u>Exemplify grit and perseverance</u>, and <u>maintain Self-control</u>. What do these characteristics mean and how are they important? What impact can a person have by demonstrating them?

Your job is to develop original and thoughtful answers to these questions using one of the following presentation methods: poster, essay, or digital presentation (such as a TED Talk). The requirements for each category are as follows:

Poster

- Colorful illustration that creates a visual image of the underlined characteristics listed above
- 11X17 paper (paper can be obtained in the front office)
- Must include the contest guestion and the above listed traits

Essay

- Addresses the contest question and includes the underlined traits in a thoughtful, wellcomposed essay
- 250-500 words
- Typed, 1" margins double-spaced, 12 point font, Times New Roman

Digital Presentation

- Addresses the contest question and includes the underlined traits in a thoughtful, wellorganized digital presentation.
- Creative presentation is well-focused, informative, engaging, and uses media effectively
- Should be 2:30 to 3:00 minutes in length

Prizes

Gift card prizes will be awarded to the top three winners in each category. First place winners will also have an additional honor.
